ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

From consumers who aren't paying attention, to clients that couch their comments with "Don't interpret this..." and moments when the information is just unclear or too surprising to quickly process, at some point interpreters will face the dilemma of not conveying information they have received in the source language to the target language.

Confronted by competing interests, it can be difficult to overcome the inertia of silence, and the easy way out is to just let chunks of information pass by. The workshop will explore some of those sticky situations and discuss strategies for maintaining our professional responsibilities guided by the RID CPC and the NCIHC SOP documents.

- Identify four situations that put the interpreter at risk of omitting information.
- Describe three strategies for mitigating omitted information.
- Memorize the first ethical principle and Standard of Practice #6 from NCIHC.
- Memorize CPC tenets 2.3 and 4.4.
